

Decision to National Convention (Central Committee/General Body Meeting) in PARBHANI

As per resolution adapted in Central Council Meeting in Delhi on 29.6.2007 it is decided to hold National Convention (Central Committee/General Body Meeting) in PARBHANI on 16th, 17th, 18th 2007. CWC Meeting will be held on 15th (AN).

Resolution is reproduced here.

[5.2]. National Convention : Gen.Secy informed the house that it's the responsibility of central body to hold National Convention. He mentioned the options like Kolkata, Hyderabad, Delhi and Parbhani to hold 15th National Convention.

After detailed deliberations and discussing all possibilities central council unanimously decided to hold 15th National Convention at PARBHANI (Maharashtra) on 16th, 17th and 18th Nov'2007. CWC will be in the AN of 15th NOV'2007.

Sh. N.L.Deshmukh AGS (WZ) and Sh. M.P.Joshi (VP-WZ) started explaining the proposal. Sh. Prokash Chakraborty VP(AIR) interrupted and suggested the house that first Convener and Chairman of National Convention should be selected.

House applauded his suggestion and Sh.N.L.Deshmukh AGS-WZ is elected Convener and Sh. M.P.Joshi (VP-WZ) elected Chairman unanimously.

Sh. Deshmukh and Sh. Joshi explained the proposal requested every body for active cooperation

House resolved to allow Convention Committee to open one Core banking Account with the title "ARTEE – NATIONAL CONVENTION, PARBHANI".

Invitees for National Convention

Article 36 of the Constitution

i. There shall be a Central Committee, under the chairmanship of President. This will consists of members of the Central Working Committee, Assistant Secretaries of Zonal Committees, Organising & Publicity Secretaries of the States, DMC Coordinators and 92 representatives from AIR & TV (DDK/PGF/PPC) stations recommended by the respective State Secretaries. (Out of this 92, One each from the states of Andman & Nicobar, Arunachal Pradesh, Goa, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim & Tripura. Three each from the states of Assam, Chhattisgarh, Delhi, Jammu & Kashmir, Jharkhand, Pujab & Chandigarh and Uttaranchal. Five each from the states of Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Orissa, Rajasthan, Tamilnadu & Pondicherry, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal)). (Old Article 24 modified)

Explanations of Article 36 :

(a). All Central Executive, Central Council, Central Working Committee members are invited.

(b). All Assistant Secretaries of Zonal Committees are invited

[c]. Publicity Secretaries & Organising Secretaries of States are invited.

(c). All DMC Cordinators are invited.

(d). In addition to above invitees following 92 representatives are invited :

One each from the states of Andman & Nicobar, Arunachal Pradesh, Goa, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim & Tripura.

Total Invitees - 11

Three each from the states of Assam, Chhattisgarh, Delhi, Jammu & Kashmir, Jharkhand, Pujab & Chandigarh and Uttaranchal.

Total Invitees - 21

Five each from the states of Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Orissa, Rajasthan, Tamilnadu & Pondicherry, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal))

Total Invitees - 60

Invitees will be selected by State Secretaries.

ii. General Secretary shall have the power to invite a maximum of ten Special Invitees (without voting power) to the meeting of the Central Committee.

All are requested to follow the above decisions and clarifications. All ARTEEians are requested to extend full cooperation.
