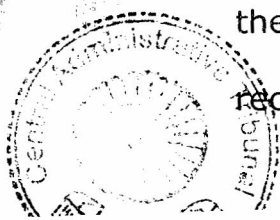

The present Contempt Petition has been filed against the non-implementation of the direction contained in this Tribunal's order dated 06.01.2012. By said order, the respondents are directed to scrutinize the applications received from various associations for the purpose of recognition etc.



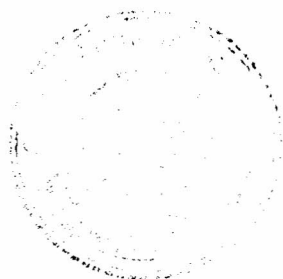
2. The learned counsel for the respondents, Sh. Rajeev Sharma submits that the matter has been dealt with at various levels and now it is at the stage of being finalized. In this regard he has shown internal notings of the respondent-Ministry as well as Prasar Bharti. We note that the respondents have already listed 10 associations including the three associations in the present OA for being considered and grant ^{of} recognition.

In the circumstances, we are inclined to dispose of the present Contempt Petition with a direction to the respondents to take a final decision in the matter of recognition of the applicants-association within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and provide a copy of the same to the applicants. In case this is not done by the respondents, the applicants-association would be at liberty to approach this Tribunal by way of appropriate proceedings. Notices issued to the respondents are discharged.
