Subject: ARTEE's concern about transfer of staff on sensitive posts in compliance of instructions by

Respected Sir,

With warm regards, we have come to know that Prasar Bharati is going to transfer the staff working on sensitve posts to comply with CVC Guidelines. We welcome decision of Prasar Bharati and it is much awaited step towards bringing transparency in day to day functioning of our department. In this reference we want to mention that DG(AIR) on intsructions of Prasar Bharati has issued an order on 9/04/2014 (copy enclosed) to transfer all staff Members who have completed 15 yrs of service at one place. The order is not clear on following things.

- [1]. Whether only staff posted on sentsitive posts for more than 15 yrs will be transferred to comply CVC instructions or everyone who has completed 15 yrs shall be transferred. If everyone completed 15 yrs at station has to be transferred we would like to share our concerns as given below:
- (a). We are aware that as per transfer policy maximum tenure at one station is four yrs. Our transfer policy does not provide any protection more stay more than this duration except considerations on humanitarian grounds. But it is impractical to transfer staff in bulk because:
- (i). Already accute staff shortage is persisting at stations. It will be difficult to run stations if bulk transfers are done.
- (ii) As per transfer policy Staff Recruited Locally like Tech, D.E.D., Helpers can not be transferred because post once vaccant by transfer can be filled by Recruitment which is a rare comidity these days.
- (iii). Prasar Bharati is facing funds shortage and many a time, measures to met out the fund shortage are dissussed in meetings at various levels. If bulk transfers are done it will cause a big dent in the form of huge amount of transfer related allowances, which we think PB is not in position to bear.

It is also reported that some of our overenthusuastic transfer authorities particularly in Zones are preparing to transfer staff in bulk without any human considerations. We are of the view that only the staff posted on sensitive posts should be transferred. In other cases transfers should be done only where it is necessary and in the interest of department. Melrequest your high office to take action accordingly to save staff from this gross injustice. ज्यक प्राप्ति

Subject:- Transfer of Staff members staying at one Zone and Stations for a long time.

Reference this Directorate s order of even no. dated 28.01,2014 and 11.03,2014 and the subject mentioned above.

- 2. A meeting was held in Central Vigilance Commission recently with the Heads of Departments/CVOs. In the meeting the Commission expressed displeasure over non-compliance of the instructions issued by the Deptt. of Pers. & Training for effecting rotational transfer of officials holding sensitive posts. It has been observed by them that periodic rotational transfers are not taking place in PrasarBharati. Taking cognisance of the same, the PrasarBharatiSectt. have also issued directions to DG:AIR to implement the policy/instructions of the DoP&T and the CVC on the subject in letter and spirit.
- 3. Keeping in view the above, all Zonal ADG (E), ADG (P), and the Heads of Capital Stations are directed to transfer all such officers/officials who have completed more than fifteen years at one Station (except the local recruitees e.g. Group D officials etc.)
- 4. All Zonal ADG (E), ADG (P) are also requested to compile the Action Taken Report of their respective Zone and submitti to the Directorate at the <u>earliest and latest</u> by 31st May, 2014.
- 5. It may be appreciated that the CVC being the statutory body, the instructionsissued by it should be strictly complied with. Non-submission of the Action Taken Report would lead to stringent action and reprimand of the delinquent officers.
