## <u>Threat of De-Recognition to One, - All are</u> <u>United to Protest</u>

On 12.03.2015, In a strange move DDA (Welfare), DG(AIR) served a letter to the President, PSA asking him to explain "why action should not be taken for De Recognition of the Association". This letter came as a surprise and left all Associations stunned. Immediately representatives of Six Associations i.e. Programme Staff Association (PSA), ARTEE, ADTEA, ADASA, ADSA (Akashwani and Doordarshan Stenographers Association), Gr 'D' Union assembled and approached Prasar Bharati Management against this unwarranted move.

In an urgent meeting, Principle Advisor including other Officers were appraised about the issue. Sensing the seriousness of the issue PA(PA) consulted the issue with CEO and after discussion with CEO, PA(PA) conveyed that CEO asked PSA to submit a Representation and after that a Speaking Order will be issued to make this letter null and void.

We, while expressing satisfaction on the fact that Six Associations out of ten, united immediately on an attack on one of the Recognized Associations, we feel that such extreme actions, which may be a threat to Industrial Peace and Cordial atmosphere, should be avoided. Efforts should be done to settle the issue amicably.
