

Resolution Adopted in Central Executive Meeting held on 01st April 2016 about Organizational Matters

Central Executive discussed the current scenario of stalemate due to ongoing Civil Suites filed by Sh. Prokash Chakraborty and Sh. Ashwani Dagar.

Sh. Gajendra Sharma, VP(AIR) informed the house about his discussions with Sh. Kuldeep Bhan. (Power of Attorney of Sh. Prokash Chakraborty, Plaintiff)

ARTEE President also briefed the House about a meeting with ARTEE members of AIR Directorate and Broadcasting House in Room No. 314 on 30th March 2016.

After detailed discussion House adopted the following Resolution.

“In the light of discussion held between Sh. Gajendra Sharma, VP(AIR) and Sh. Kuldeep Bhan. (Power of Attorney of Sh. Prokash Chakraborty, Plaintiff in Civil Suite in Patiala House and in continuation of our efforts to solve the issue amicably with positive intent, House welcomed the gesture shown by Plaintiff through the suggestion of withdrawing the Civil Suites.”

On this development the House adopted the following Resolution.

“House Resolve that If both the Civil Suites are withdrawn by Plaintiff Sh. Ashwini Dagar and Sh. Prokash Chakraborty unconditionally before 8th April 2016, elections will be conducted as per bylaws passed by 17th General Body, Allahabad on 20.11.2015.”

“A meeting of Central Council will be called as early as possible, the issue of Re-Notifying the Elections will be discussed in the Central Council meeting and decision with positive intent will be taken accordingly. All efforts will be done, that Elections are conducted as early as possible. The House also expressed its satisfaction on the progress of the efforts made to solve the crisis. “

House also discussed the scenario of not withdrawing the cases.

In such situation, The House resolved to defend these cases as per law of the land and judicial process with full might of the Association.
