

Clarification about Comments on the Proposed Draft Recruitment Rules Amendment by Prasar Bharati.

All members please be informed that on proposed draft Recruitment Rules Prasar Bharati has asked comments from stakeholders within in 30 days. A copy is marked to ARTEE also. Accordingly we have uploaded a detailed report on our website, **(Click here to read the report)** inviting comments from our Members. Many Members have already sent their suggestions to us. We are compiling these suggestions.

Meanwhile some ex leaders prepared their own representation and asking our Members to submit that to Hon'ble Secretary Ministry of I&B and CEO. Not only this can invite action under CCS conduct Rules but also an Activity against the discipline of the Association. However we welcome submission of suggestions to us.

Any leader involved in such Anti Association Act is also cautioned. All Members please note that the Recruitment Rules Amendment work is heading with the efforts of Central Office and some ex leaders are finding themselves unable to digest the success of ARTEE Central Office in this matter. The proposed Recruitment Rules have many good points like:

- (1). Merger in 4600 GP (not in 4200 as proposed in the era of same ex. leaders).
- (2). Grant of 5400 GP on completion of 4 years to all AEs.

There is always scope of improvement like Designations, grant of 5400 in PB III on completion of four years etc.

We will take up Merger of Tech/Sr.Tech also and DG (AIR) has already send proposal for that.

But, we appeal all Members not to fall in the political propaganda to drag the whole exercise into controversies so that it is stopped or delayed indefinitely. Please note that these Recruitment Rules Amendments are necessary to stop the recovery and to remove stagnation.

Also note that this not Cadre Review. Hence, we can not address all anomalies through this Recruitment Rule Amendment. This is just the Recruitment Rule Amendment for the merged post of EA/ SEA and we intend to take up issue of Tech/Sr.Tech also. All other anomalies will be taken in the detailed Cadre Review Exercise. **For full details please go through report published earlier in our website/**
