RO/ARO/ZARO agreed to take back his Resignation and start the work when the above decisions will be executed. House expressed it's gratitude for his services and assured full cooperation.

After this the packets received by President on Friday and Monday were dropped in Ballot box. Total 34 Articles were received on Friday and 58 today. As per sources of GPO no other packet was received through Speed Post.

All participents unanimously agreed to stand firm and United to make ARTEE strong and formidable.
