Sub: Reminder Letter for completing MACP DPC for eligible subordinate technical staff - Reg.

Respected Sir,

With reference to our earlier representations on this subject, it is distressing that so far no action has been taken to give justice to hundreds of subordinate technical staff who have been deprived of their eligible MACP benefits since 2014, when our Department stopped convening MACP DPC. This is causing extreme de-motivation and despair among the staff.

As submitted in our earlier letters, there are many among subordinate technical staff who are fulfilling the basic requirements for MACP. They have been languishing without promotion for decades. For example, hundreds of Direct Recruittee EAs have been in same post since their joining way back in 1990. Likewise, many Technicians and Helpers have been in same post for more than 20 years. They have completed 10/20/30 years of continuous residency period in same scale / Grade Pay without promotion, counted from direct entry grade. They have become eligible for commensurate MACP benefits as per Clause 1, Annexure-I of MACP OM. DPC may be immediately revived for such cases.

Due to this denial, the basic purpose of MACP Scheme, namely, giving relief to staff who have been deprived of promotions due to stagnation, is being defeated.

Hence, we once again request your good self to initiate immediate action to release MACP to eligible engineering employees.
