

Minutes of the Meeting of E-in-C with representatives of ARTEE on various issues related to East Zone:

The following action-points were arrived at:

1. Proposal for sanction of posts in Plan shall be submitted by the CE(P)-EZ with justification, which will be forwarded to Ministry by Directorate with recommendations. The Association's grievance regarding maintenance of plan posts at 2001 level in various cadres shall be considered taking also in to account engagement of installation staff for maintaining and running installations brought about without O&M staff.
2. E-in-C, AIR directed CE(EZ) to issue the transfer list in various cadres, which is pending since June 09, as per the prevailing system.
3. Regarding the vacancies for promotions, CE(EZ) along with representatives of Association shall verify all the available vacancies.
4. Regarding the proposal for creation of supernumerary posts to accommodate promotion to the vacancies for the period 1st April 2003 to August 2003, it was decided that the proposal will be sent to the appropriate authorities for consideration, if rules permit, for granting justice to the deprived candidates. The matter had earlier come up for discussion in a meeting taken by E-in-C, AIR

with the representatives of ARTEE and ADTEA on 9-10-06 in which a decision was taken to refer the case to DOPT for final decision.

5. The transfer policy guidelines regarding shifting persons in accordance with their length of stay shall be followed. There shall be no discrimination in relieving the employees under order of transfer in various cadres and grades.
6. Regarding recognition of Association, it was directed to follow the order issued from the Directorate in this regard.
7. It was decided that CE(P)-EZ & CE(M)-EZ shall hold a meeting with zonal representatives of Association every month to settle the matters at the zonal level.
