(4) Members of the Indian Information Service, the Central Secretariat Service or any other service and persons borne on cadres outside Akashvani and Doordarshan who have been working in Prasar Bharati immediately before the appointed day or thereafter, shall continue to work in Akashvani or Doordarshan on deputation in accordance with such terms and conditions as may be prescribed.
