MARCH TO PARLIAMENT ON 26TH JULY 2012

Confederation of Central Government Employees & Workers is an umbrella Organisation unifying the entirety of Central Government Employees and Workers on a single platform. ARTEE is the only affiliate of Confederation from AIR & Doordarshan. We have been receiving support from Confederation on our movements from time to time. It is therefore important for us to move along the Confederation on important issues, especially in the light of our retention as Central Government employees (as of now there a cut off date, but we a spire to have uniformity without this cut-off date).

The Confederation of Central Govt Employees and Workers, New Delhi in its National Executive Committee meeting at Kolkata on 29th April 2012 decided to mobilise the central government employees across the country on a 14 point charter of demands and to organise a :March to Parliamentøon 26th July 2012 followed by one day strike during the winter session of Parliament (*i.e.* in November-December 2012).

Confederation has allocated quota for each station/state for mobilisation in the #March to Parliamentø and also has chalked out a tour programme of leaders to almost every state. The Confederation Circular is enclosed.

Central government employees have been participating in similar Marches to Parliament, nation-wide strikes and agitational programmes organised under the banner of :Central Trade Unionsøon the demands specific to respective organisations and departments. But it is after a long time that a movement is being attempted on exclusive demands of the central government employees.

The Charter of demands on which the \pm March to Parliamentø and one day strike call are being organised, is given separately here.

The Tour programme of the leaders of Confederation at various places is available in the circular issued by the Secretary General of the Confederation. Our office bearers and members are requested to cooperate and coordinate with the representatives of the Confederation to make the campaign programme a grand success.

All our CWC Members/ DMC Coordinators, units secretaries as well as members are requested to take initiatives to mobilise the central government employees and their organisations in their stations so as to ensure one of the best mobilisations of the central government employees in the March to Parliament.

Let us ensure our maximum participation in this fight of Confederation to protect the rights of Central Government Employees.
