Sub: Issues raised by NFADE : - request for urgent meeting

Ref: Meeting held with Hon'ble Minister on 15/3/2010 Written assurances by Ministry & CEO Prasar Bharati

Respected Madam,

As your goodself is kindly aware, we, the 38000 employees (ranging from Group D to SAG level officials) of AIR &Doordarshan, proposed to avail one day Mass Casual Leave on 17/3/2010 on part of our 6th phase of agitation.

We have deferred the agitation only after the sympathetic hearing by you and the assurances extended in writing from the Ministry as well as CEO, Prasar Bharati that the demand of NFADE to Repeal Prasar Bharati Act 1990, will be presented in front of the Hon'ble GoM.

Accordingly we have submitted the main points describing the fate of AIR & DD and its employees after the implementation of PB Act 1990, especially due to the mismanagement in Prasar Bharati (Copy attached).

But it is very unfortunate that inspite of his assurances, the demand and view points of the employees have not been presented in front of Hon'ble GoM by the CEO, Prasar Bharati, due to the reasons best known to him. On the other hand it seems that the CEO Prasar Bharati has made deliberate efforts to mislead the Hon'ble GoM by presenting an artificial financial picture of Prasar Bharati, "claiming that the Prasar Bharati earns revenue to meet 50% of the Expenditure". We wonder if your high office is also convinced with the proposal, especially when Prasar Bharati drained out a good amount from the reserve fund to meet the expenditure.

Under these circumstances, we request your goodself to kindly grant an urgent meeting to this Federation at your convenience so that we can bring the realities to your kind notice.
