Respected Madam,

We request your kind attention to the notice of agitation, dated 09/8/2010, through which we have brought the agitation programme into your kind notice.

We have brought it very clearly to your kind notice that employees are agitated due to the efforts of PB Management to mislead Hon'ble GoM and your office, claiming an artificial rosy financial picture of Prasar Bharati whereas the reality is on the other side, especially when these Federation/individual Associations are struggling every month to get even the salary of the employees in time.


We had demanded to take up the issue, of Repeal PB Act 1990, at the proper platform and to stop the activities for the implementation of Prasar Bharati, till taking a final decision by Hon'ble Parliament of India, especially when your goodself and Hon'ble GoM did not turned down the demand of Repeal PB Act 1990, but pointed out only that it is not in the purview of the Hon'ble GoM.


Accordingly we had declared the following agitation programme:

1. 24 Hours Boycott of duties from 9 am of 14th September 2010 to 9am of 15<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2010.
2. 48 Hours Boycott of duties from 9am of 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2010 to 9am of 25<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2010.
3. 72 Hours Boycott of duties from 9am of 13<sup>th</sup> December 2010 to 9am of 16<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2010 which will be converted into indefinite Boycott of duties, if the need arises.

We had pointed out in the notice that we are avoiding any agitation programme in October 2010 in National Interest, in the light of Commonwealth Games. Meeting of the Federation held on 07/9/2010 observed that works of Host Broadcaster has been delayed due to the extra ordinary delay in the completion of stadiums and thereby 24 hrs boycott of duties can further delay the preparations for the coverage by Doordarshan as Host Broadcaster and AIR & DD as Rights holder Broadcaster.

**Under this situation we have decided to avoid the 1<sup>st</sup> programme, i.e., 24 Hours Boycott of duties from 9 am of 14th September 2010 to 9am of 15<sup>th</sup> September 2010, in the wider interest of the National Broadcaster & country whereas the other agitation programme as per the notice dated 09/8/2010 will remain as it is..**




