





**demand to grant ACP to subordinate Engg. and Program Cadres in the spirit of verdict of Hon'ble Sup. Court without withdrawing agreement of 25<sup>th</sup> Feb 1999.**

**3]. Grant of Pay Parity to Technicians with Sr. Technician with Lighting Assistants as per verdict of Hon'ble High Court Chennai :**

There have been a anomaly persisting since long, disparity between Tech and Lighting Assistant and Associations have been demanding to remove it. In a case filed by ADTEA the Hon'ble High Court Chennai gave verdict to grant notional pay fixation to Technician and Sr. Technician in parity with Lighting Assistants. Which is to be implemented by or 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2011. DG AIR (the Cadre Controlling Authority) and Prasar Bharati agreed to the decision of Hon'ble High Court, Chennai and sent the Ministry of I & B for implementation.

SSS waited for considerable time for implementation but it is being delayed and Tech. & Sr.Tech are deprived of the benefit. **SSS demand immediate implementation of verdict of Hon'ble High Court of Patna.**

**4]. Merger of EA with SEA as per the order of DOPT :**

As per the 6<sup>th</sup> CPC recommendations and as per an order of DOPT the employees working in pre revised scale of 5500-10500 (GP 4200) are merged with 7450-11500 (GP 4600). After this financial merger the Recruitments rules are to be amended and Engg. Assistants are to be merged with Sr. Engg. Asstts. For this purpose a committee was formed under the Chairmanship of Chief Engineer (Development) All India Radio and recommendations of the committee were sent to Ministry of I & B after getting the nod from DG AIR and Prasar Bharati. The recommendations are in Ministry and since the amendments are not approved the Examination for the promotions from SEA to AE could not be conducted. Some Individuals & ADTEA have approached the Hon'ble CAT for the merger and Hon'ble court also directed the Govt. to merge these cadres. **SSS demand to merge Engg. Asstts with Sr. Engg. Asstts. without any further delay.**

**5]. Withdrawal of Agreement dated 25<sup>th</sup> Feb 1999. :** SSS want to register its strong resentment on the news of recommending withdrawal of Agreement dated 1999 by Committee of Joint Secys. There will be widespread after affected of any such kind of move and it will jeopardize the functioning of the department as a whole. So We demand to stop any move to withdraw of 1999 agreement.

**6]. Intrusion of Outsourced man power through BECIL and Retired persons :** The SSS strongly oppose the entry of man power through BECIL and deploying Retired persons. It is not only diluting the quality of service but also allowing the access of the persons whom loyalty towards the organization is questionable as the credentials of these outsourced staff are not certified. It is also surprising that these outsourced people are being given the priority over regular employees of AIR and Doordsrahan. It is also surprising that, Some of the top officials are favoring BECIL in deploying the outsourced staff. Possibility of any nexus between our top boses and BECIL can not be ruled out. Role played by BECIL during Common wealth Games is also questionable. There have been incidents of gross indiscipline by these outsourced employees.

**SSS demand that there should not be any outsourcing neither in Engg. and nor in Program Cadres in AIR & DD and the problem of staff shortage Regular recruitment should be met with regular requirement.**

**7]. Security of AIR & DD Installations :** As a responsible welfare organization we have been regularly raising our voice against the fragile security of the premier installations of AIR and DD. The security of DD in particular is under clout of doubt. There have been reports that some supplier are having access to the DG DD through permanent pass showing them as regular employees. We also demanded that security of Akashwani & DD should be handed over to CISF. But of no use. **SSS demand a fool proof system of security which can be in position by handing over security of Akashwani & Doordsrahan Bhawan to CISF.**



**Cadre Review of Sub ordinate Engg. & Program cadres.** : The Cadre review exercise of Engg. employees is pending at a very slow pace. The Cadre review is done as employees of Air & DD could be accommodated at last moment and there was no cadre based study conducted for us. The Cadre Review exercise is needed to grant justice to subordinate cadres from Helper to AEs. It is also pertinent to mention that Helper the lowest cadre in the hierarchy has no Sr. cum Fitness Promotion quota to the post of Tech and because of they are also deprived the benefit of ACP. On the other hand Diesel Engine Drivers, D.Tech and Mast Tech. cadres are also demanding from joining the merger into mainstream cadres. The Cadre Review Exercise is the only solution of all cadre based problems of sub ordinate cadres.

**to SSS demand to implement Cadre Review in a time bound manner.**






