Election of Unit Committees after 2 year term

Dear Unit Secretaries.

I invite your attention to section 5 ii) of our constitution which says that 'At each unit, members shall elect one Unit Secretary, one Assistant Unit Secretary and one Unit Treasurer. At units where numbers of members are more than 20 they will elect one more representative, Assistant Unit Secretary. After being elected they should communicate their names to the General Secretary. They shall hold office for a period of two years'.

Further, DOP&T, in its order vide F.No.4/1/2002-CS.IV; Dated 9th March, 2007 clarified that as per the CCS (RSA) Rules: "An Office-bearer should have a fixed term not exceeding two years. If elections are not held within three months of expiry of the term, the office bearer will cease to be duly-elected representatives of the Association."

Since we are in the process of Recognition as per the revised rules and we have to follow the Constitution as well as the guidelines of CCS (RSA) Rules 1993, *I hereby request all unit Secretaries having completed two year term, to complete the election process (or reelection, as the case may be) latest by 30th April 2012 to avoid any legal complications.*

Further, all unit secretaries are requested to take care of this condition and to complete the election process as soon as possible. The list of newly elected unit committees may be intimated to the General Secretary.
