Dear Comrades, You are all aware that in a meeting held on 27th September 2007 the Secretary, Ministry of I&B, agreed to propose our demand of retention in Government, as an official proposal before the Hon'ble GoM. It was also decided in the meeting to constitute a committee chaired by the Secretary, I&B to consider and recommend amendments in the PB Act to find a permanent solution. We have already submitted the names of the NFADE representatives for the said committee. Ministry of I&B has constituted the committee on 26/10/2007. Copy of the notification available in page No.13

The Hon'ble Group of Ministers, in its meeting held on 5th October 2007, has approved the proposal of our Ministry to retain employees of AIR & Doordarshan with Government of India and to immediately restore all the facilities of Central Government employees including the benefits of the recommendations of the VIth Central Pay Commission.

NFADE representatives met Sh. Jaipal Reddy, Hon'ble Minister for Urban Development on 4th October in which he assured the Federation that the orders will be issued to restore the allotments in General Pool Accommodation to the employees of AIR&DD immediately. It is learnt that hon'ble Minister has also declared the same in the meeting of GoM on 5th October.

We met Sh.Priya Ranjan Dasmuni, Hon'ble Minister for I&B on 7th October 2007 (Sunday) in which we were told that efforts will be made to amend Section 11 of PB Act to retain the employees of AIR&DD as Central Government employees with all the facilities.

It is indeed a historical victory in employees' movement that perhaps Prasar Bharati will be the first autonomous corporation to be manned with Government employees. We extend our heartily congratulations to all the members of all constituent Associations/Unions representing members from Group D to SAG level employees. We have made another history of unity and solidarity of employees of all these cadres to protect our cause. This is the victory of the united force not of any individual.

While celebrating the victory, we have to be more vigilant by maintaining this unity, to ensure that the proposals are approved by Hon'ble Parliament and subsequently it becomes the law of the land.

Once again we express our sincere gratitude to each and every member for the solidarity and wish to maintain the same for future achievements.

We will win if united and perish if divided. Let us forget the divisions forever.

With regards this is in continuation of meeting held in your office on 14.9.2007 about the delay in declaring the results of Examination for promotion from SEA to AE. The examination was held in the month of June. It is requested to declare the result at the earliest as after the result DPC is to be conducted and promotion list is to be released. It is our experience since last so many years that since the result is prepared late the list is delayed which effects eligibility in further promotions.

During meeting with you it was also pointed out that on the efforts of this Association from last year management started displaying results on Internet. This move was appreciated and received a warm response since this is era of transparency. It was requested to continue this practice.

We also want to bring in you kind notice that there are no promotional avenues available in East Zone as an effect of Bifurcating erstwhile East Zone into East Zone and North East Zone. Some vacancies are expected in East Zone which will open some promotional venues for East Zone suffering since last five years.

The convention was started with the hosting of ARTEE flag by Sri Anil Kumar S President in the presence of Sh.Umesh Chandra, General Secretary and Dr. S.K. Grover DDG Doordarshan, Superintending Engineer, of Doordarshan and All India Radio, dedicated members of ARTEE of 62 Kendras of AIR and Doordarshan. Function was inaugurated by Dr. S.K. Grover. In a houseful auditorium. State secretary U.P. welcomed the dignities, the President, General Secretary, other central/Zonal office bearers & Delegates of U.P., members and office bearers of constitute association of NFADE.

Chief guest Dr. S.K. Grover while inaugurating the Convention, said "only ARTEE can protect the rights of employees and need of unity in such crucial juncture. Member Personnel while inaugurating the Convention, assured of sincere efforts from Prasar Bharati Secretariat in solving various issues related to the staff members. He assured necessary action from Prasar Bharati to increase the time slot for regional transmission, to remove the ambiguities in conditions for scrawling advertisements from LPTVs and starting of FM transmission from Thrissur.

Sri. M. Shivakumar, SEA, AIR, Trivandrum and Sri. K.V. Ramachandran, SE, AIR, Trivandrum were felicitated in the convention for the indigenous development of the software 'VIRTUAL STUDIO'. This is a comprehensive solution for AIR stations and has already saved crores of rupees for the department.

A meeting with the employees of Prasar Bharati was held at 3.30 p.m. on 27.9.2007. The issue with regard to status of employees of Prasar Bharati was deliberated at length. After detailed discussions the following was agreed to :-

1. On behalf of the Government, it was agreed that in the GOM meeting to be held on 5th Oct., 2007, Ministry would put forward the proposal that the employees of Prasar Bharati who are Government employees, will continue to be Government employees. However since they have been placed at the disposal of the Prasar Bharati, they will be on 'deemed deputation' with Prasar Bharati under Rule 37A of CCS Pension Rules.
2. It was further agreed that a committee chaired by Secretary (I&B) would be constituted by the Government which would include 2 or 3 representatives from the employees side along with management representatives to consider and recommend amendments to the Prasar Bharati Act to find a permanent solution. The recommendations of the Committee would be submitted by 30.11.2007.
3. Prasar Bharati and Ministry of I&B after scrutinizing the recommendations would place the same before the GOM for their perusal and approval in consultation with the concerned Ministries.
4. On receiving approval from GOM further necessary action in the matter will be taken up.

In view of the agreement reached as stated above, the employees agreed to withdraw the proposed mass casual leave scheduled for 28th Sept., 2007. They also assured that complete normalcy will prevail and the functioning of Doordarshan and AIR will be normal as usual.

ACP for employees of engineering cadres

As mentioned in the last issue of FILMENT, ARTEE has been making its efforts to extend the benefit of Assured Career Progression (ACP) as recommended by 5th Central Pay Commission since long. Department was compelled to take up the matter even with DOP&T twice on the demand of ARTEE, which was turned down by DOP&T both times on various grounds. We have taken up the matter again with the present CEO & Member (Personnel) also. Meanwhile some of our members of AIR, DDK, O/o CE(EZ) Kolkata and HPT, Chinsurah have filed a case in Hon'ble CAT Kolkata for a legal remedy. Though 14 EA members under the leadership of Sh. Subhas Datta &

Sh. Kaushik Ghatak started the case for ACP, the financial assistance afterwards was given by East Zone Committee of ARTEE. Hon'ble CAT Kolkata, in its order dated 09/08/2007 "**directed the respondents (Govt and Prasar Bharati) to refix the pay after granting ACP to the applicants in the scale of Pay of Rs.7450-11500 within ninety days from the date of receipt of the copy of the order with effect from the date on which they are entitled to and pay all consequential benefits accordingly**".

Accordingly we have submitted the following letter to the member personnel on 19/9/2007 requesting to implement the CAT order at the earliest.

I would like to bring to your kind notice that the Assistant Engineers of CCW have won a similar case on 04/8/2004 from the same court and the department has granted pay up-gradation under ACP scheme to all eligible Assistant Engineers of CCW (AIR) vide the order in reference No.4.(Copy attached for your kind reference). It is worthwhile to mention that these AEs were also deprived of the benefits under ACP on the excuse of Scales in the name of Prasar Bharati pay Scales and they have been granted as per the directive of Hon'ble CAT Kolkata.

I request your good self to kindly take necessary steps to grant the pay scale of Rs.7450 – 11500 to the EAs as per the ACP scheme as directed by the Hon'ble CAT Kolkata.

We are confident that kind efforts from your good office will make the difference.
