Dear Comrades,

In continuation of their efforts to destroy ARTEE, Mr.Bachchu Singh Meena and Mr.Ram Shanker filed a case in the Hon'ble High Court, Allahabad, challenging the renewal of registration of ARTEE . They have demanded the Hon'ble High Court to set aside the order of renewal of Registration of ARTEE issued by the Asst Registrar of Societies and to freeze the bank accounts of ARTEE.

Central office immediately contacted the advocates in Allahabad in coordination with Sh.Jairam Singh, Unit Secretary, AIR Allahabad. Hon'ble High Court in its verdict stated that **admission of this case for no reason will add in the bulk of the court. The case was disposed of by making observation that "it will be for the petitioner to move fresh representation before the concerned authority and it will be for the concerned authority to look into the matter and to take appropriate decision provided the claim of the petitioner has already been decided or it has already become barred by time or by any law. If it will be so, it will be for the concerned competent authority to simply reject the petitioner's claim/ representation".**

Sh.Jairam Singh, AIR Allahabad has taken all pains to coordinate the hectic work at Allahabad along with his dedicated team.

Thereby the efforts of the erstwhile sons of a mother (ARTEE) to destroy the mother ,who gave them everything including the name they had among the members, has once again become futile. It is heard that, after realizing that they cannot destroy this prestigious Association , now these persons are trying make a step mother perhaps to kill it after getting the personal interests once again. We are confident that our wise members will give a fitting reply to such individuals.

We once again extend our salute to all our office bearers, members and well-wishers through out the country who stand alongside us in this hour of experiments. We are sure that our members across the country are very well capable to keep ARTEE intact.

Short Notes:

Meeting with E-in-C,AIR:

Though the bifurcation of man power in EZ & NEZ took place in august 2003, the problems created from the unplanned implementation of the decision are yet to be solved.

Both the Zonal offices of EZ & NEZ have been agitating to find out a permanent solution to the burning issue. On the demand of the Central office, E-in-C,AIR has called a formal meeting with the representatives of ARTEE & ADTEA under the chairmanship of Sh.A.S.Guin, Engineer-in-Chief, All India Radio at 1500 hours on 09.10.2006. When the chairman narrated the necessity of calling the meeting to address the issues surfaced as a result of bifurcation of the East Zone into East Zone & North-East Zone, Association representatives pointed out, that all the problems have been created by the unplanned and unscientific bifurcation of the zones and demanded that responsibility should be fixed on the officials responsible for the fiasco.

Whereas in 2003, in similar cases of creations & bifurcations of various states, divisions of Railways etc., no apparent problems cropped up.

Chairman called upon the participants to forget the defects of the past and suggested that fixing the responsibility will not solve the problems. He also asked Associations to give their suggestions and assured all possible efforts to find out amicable solution to solve the issues.

Associations pointed out that the proposal for merger Sr. Technician with EA and SEA with AE, which has been already approved by the Prasar Bharati Board is the permanent solution for most of the issues linked with the bifurcation.

It was informed by the Official side that the proposal is pending with Ministry after the financial implications for the same has been submitted to the Ministry.

On the demand of the staff side, Chairman informed that he himself will approach the Ministry for fast disposal of merger proposal from PB Board in view of the problem of surplus staff in East Zone. The Chairman assured to take up the issue on war footing.

Thereafter we had a very lengthy discussion on various issues such as:

Excess SEA's in East Zone, Unilateral posting of EAs & SEAs to some of the stations of NEZ by_EZ_ Dispute over Zonal option in respect of few SEAs, Zonal Option for Direct Recruit EAs of 2002 batch, Special recruitment drive for North East Zone, Shifting of Project wing from EZ to NEZ, NE Package for the staff of EZ working in NEZ, Promotion for the left out candidates for the vacancies prior to August 2003, Adjustment of excess SEAs in East Zone. The meeting was fruitful to a large extent. Minutes are awaited.

It was assured that another meeting, but with less number of representatives will be held to follow up the action taken on these issues.

Sh.Anilkumar S, President, Sh.Umesh Chandra, General Secretary, Sh.Sunil Thapliyal, Vice-President & Treasurer, Sh.Prokash Chakraborty, VP (AIR), Sh.Kuldeep Bhan, Member DG (AIR) Council, h.Malay Kumar Das, Vice President (EZ), Sh.Dip Bordoloi, Vice President (NEZ), Sh.Biswajit Ghoshal, AGS (EZ), Sh.Subrato Goswamy, JS (EZ), Sh.L.R.Warjri, AGS, (NEZ), Sh.N. Yhome, State Secretary, (Nagaland) from ARTEE along with the office bearers of ADTEA represented the staff side.

Pramature transfer of EA from AIR Tirunelveli:

As reported earlier, Sh.Ananthamoorthy, EA, AIR Tirunelveli was transferred to AIR Tuticorin after completing merely 18 months in the 4 year tenure station. The reason told was that the recommendations of two DDGs inquired some issue in the station. But on the other side the DDGs clarified that they haven't recommended any thing against that individual. After the involvement of E-in-C when the matter was approaching to a logical end, the over smart Station Engineer has written a very strong complaint against the EA in which she predicted communal violence in Tirunelveli area if the EA been posted back to Tirunelveli. What a dangerous EA ! But interestingly she has not issued even a single memo in this regard to the dangerous person – forget about any other security measures.

After this letter ARTEE demanded that Sh.Ananthamoorthy should be joined back to AIR Tirunelveli only and necessary action against the intelligence expert SE from the station. We have demanded for detailed enquiry on the entire episode.

Sh.Anilkumar S, President, ARTEE has been nominated by NFADE as Chairman of NFADE and has taken over from Sh.R.Dasgupta w.e.f.01/09/2006. Sh.R.Dasgupta has been nominated by the general body of NFADE as National Advisor (for Life time) of NFADE.

Terms of Reference of The Sixth Central Pay Commission

- A. To examine the principles. The date of effect thereof that should govern the structure of pay, allowances and other facilities/benefits whether in cash or in kind to the following categories of employees:-
1. Central government employees – industrial and non-industrial.
 2. Personnel belonging to the All India Services.
 3. Personnel belonging to the Armed Forces.
 4. Personnel to the Union Territories.
 5. Officers and employees of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department; and
 6. Officers and employees of the regulatory bodies set up under Acts of Parliament.
- B. To transform the Central Government Organisations into modern, professional and citizen-friendly entities that are dedicated to the service of the people.
- C. To work out a comprehensive pay package for the categories of Central Government employees mentioned at (A) above that is suitably linked to promoting efficiency, productivity and economy through rationalization of structures, organizations, systems and processes within the government, with a view leveraging economy, accountability, responsibility, transparency, assimilation of technology and discipline.
- D. To harmonize the functioning of the Central Government Organisations with the demands of the emerging global economic scenario. This would also take in account, among other relevant factors, the totality of benefits available to the employees, need of rationalization and simplification, thereof, the prevailing pay structure and retirement benefits available under the Central Public Sector Undertakings, the economic conditions in the country, the need to observe fiscal prudence in the management of the economy, the resources of the Central Government and the demands thereon on account of economic and social development, defence, national security and the global economic scenario, and the impact upon the finances of the States if the recommendations are adopted by the States.
- E. To examine the principles which should govern the structure of pension, death-cum-retirement gratuity, family pension and other terminal or recurring benefits having financial implications to the present and former Central Government employees appointed before January 1, 2004.
- F. To make recommendations with respect to the general principles, financial parameters and conditions which should govern payment of bonus and the desirability and feasibility of introducing Productivity Linked Incentive Scheme in place of the existing ad hoc bonus scheme in various Departments and to recommend specific formulae for determining the productivity index and other related parameters.
- G. To examine desirability and the need to sanction any interim relief till the time the recommendations of the Commission are made and accepted by the Government.

The Commission will devise its own procedure and may appoint such Advisers, institutional consultants and experts, as it may consider necessary for any particular purpose. It may call for such information and take such evidence, as it may consider necessary. Ministries and Departments of the Government of India will furnish such information and documents and other assistance as may be required by the Commission. The Government of India trusts that State Governments, Service Association and others concerned will extend to the Commission their fullest cooperation and assistance.

The Commission will have its headquarters in Delhi.

The Commission will make its recommendations within 18 months of the date of its constitution. It may consider, if necessary, sending reports on any of the matters as and when the recommendations are finalized.

Court cases update:

The ongoing case in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on Prasar Bharati, in which NFADE also becomes a party, was called for hearing on 07/09/2006. when the matter was called on, learned Additional Solicitor General submitted that a group of Ministers, hopefully, would take a decision on the proposal of the Prasar Bharati within a period of ten weeks. Accordingly the Hon'ble supreme Court ordered to put up after ten weeks.

Sh.Rabin Dasgupta, Ex-President of ARTEE and Ex-Chairman, NFADE has retired from service on 31st august 2006. Staff members of AIR & Doordarshan has given him a grand sent off for a new innings towards the welfare activities of the staff of this media. The gathering was addressed by various dignitaries including Sh.Brijeshwar singh, CEO,PB & DG,AIR, Chief Engineers, other senior officials, leaders of various Associations etc.

Confusion on EA's pay scale for recruitment by Doordarshan

As per the requirement of DOP&T, Directorates of AIR & Doordarshan submitted the vacancy for the year 2004. But due to some communication gap among the concerned sections in Doordarshan they have send the wrong information including posts for Direct Recruitment, pay scale of various cadres etc to the Screening Committee of the Ministry of I&B. The Screening committee, while sending its report to the Directorate for filling up of 1/3 of the vacancies for the year 2004, after recommending for abolition of 2/3 vacancies has mentioned the details as shown by the Directorate of Doordarshan. Immediately after the issual of the letter we have taken up the issues of abolition of posts and misidentifying of promotional posts as DR post, purposefully ignoring the mentioning of revised pay scales for the posts in Doordarshan. We were waiting for the notification from the Directorate for vacancies in upgraded scales in Doordarshan which could have helped us a lot in our case going on in CAT Delhi for the pay revision of EAs joined after 25-02-1999. we could have even challenge the gazette notification issued in March 2002 as recommended by the 5th Pay Commission. Unfortunately some of our persons pointed out it to the Directorate of Doordarshan before the notification for filling up of of the vacancies and they have corrected the scales immediately to the Ministry by mentioning as per the gazette notification of March 2002.

The same persons have tried create confusion among our members by giving unnecessary publicity to this issue.

Let us clarify that after the agreement of 25-2-1999 and as per the gazette notification the Government issued in March 2002, the pay scales new recruits are low compare to the incumbents on 25-2-1999. we are fighting the case in CAT Delhi. We have demanded the upgraded scale for everybody irrespective of joining date in Prasar Bharati RR also.

Copy of OM No. 1/19/03-P&PW (E) dtd.11-10-2006 from Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Pension & Pensioners Welfare

Subject: Eligibility of Divorced/Widowed daughter for grant of family Pension.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) OM No. F(E)III/98/PN1/4 dated 11-10-2004 on the above mentioned subject and to clarify that the family Pension to Widow/ Divorced daughters. Under this Ministry's OM of even Number dated 25/30th August, 2004 is admissible irrespective of the fact that the divorce/widowhood takes place after attaining the age of 25 years or before attaining that age in other words the Family Pension will be admissible without age restriction subject to other conditions being satisfied.

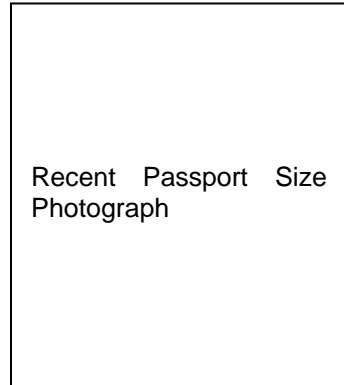
